SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please record their presence. Would those senators not in the Chamber please come and record your presence. And would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'm sorry, I asked for a procedure that's not available to me. So I guess I'll have to request a roll call vote.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Senator Abboud, Senator Matzke, Senator McKenzie, the house is under call. Senator Pirsch. Senator Schrock, Senator Hillman, the house is under call. Senator Landis, the house is under call. Senator Hillman, Senator Landis, the house is under call. Senator Maurstad, Senator Landis, we understand, is out of the building, and Senator Hillman hasn't responded, so, Mr. Clerk, would you please call the roll.
