

SEN' TOR AVERY: Can we have a call of the house?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, the house is under call. Will senators please check in. Senator Coordsen. Senator Matzke, will you check in please. Senator Bromm. Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Cudaback. Senator Hillman, please check in. Senator Schrock. CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.
