The fiduciary duty of the board comes into effect when they have to take some action relative to disposing of these lands or doing anything else with the money that they deal with on behalf of their client. So the preparing of this report has nothing to do, this plan, with the fiduciary duty of the board. So I would like to ask a question to whoever is the ringleader on this bill, let me see who that would be. Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Bernard-Stevens, are you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, let me see, I'll go down the line, this is like I said, Barnum and Bailey and that guy with the top hat who was a friend of Mae West. Senator Kris...oh, he's gone. Oh, Senator Bromm, are you on this bill?

SENATOR BROMM: Okay, the significance, in my view, is that in some of the court cases, and there have been a number of them involving sale of school lands, and the duties of the Board of Educational Lands and Funds, as you read the language, and I've got some of it here, it seems to say that even though the Legislature can direct the board to sell the school lands, we
