

the analysis to see where their money can best be spent, or whether or not they are in fact complying with their fiduciary duties by having the bulk of their assets in real estate, in the Sandhills of Nebraska. Maybe they.... You know Senator Wickersham has a bill, which is on the floor but which has not had time for debate, which requires them to diversify their land holdings and purchase some urban property. And we have to have a legislative bill, apparently, to require them even to look at that. So I don't think that we're asking for too much to ask them to do the plan. If it costs \$100,000 I'd be amazed. I guess that assumes that we're paying extra money.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: I mean they're on the salary...they're on the payroll all ready, and so I don't see the problem preparing the plan or I don't see the additional costs. However, if we're going to look at costs, if fighting bills that require them to look at selling land is within their fiduciary duties, I guess then we need those costs as well. So I do object to the amendment. I think the next amendment gets to the...Senator Withem, gets to the policy discussion a little bit more. But if we ask any of our departments to do a plan and look at doing something that we think maybe should be done, I hope that we don't...that we don't require this kind of accounting. The accounting is probably going to take as much time as the plan itself when it comes down to it. So I do encourage the body to resist the amendment
