

and bring the bill back on Final, and maybe between that time and now I can...you and I, or both of us, or each of us can come up with an idea that will not in fact endanger the counties' position and still accomplish what I agree and have no problem with in making sure that we...that it's structured so that it cannot be used in an unfair manner and still be able to provide some type of assistance in these kind of cases. So, if it's okay with you, I'll withdraw my amendment if you want to withdraw yours, and we'll wait and discuss it on Final Reading. We can bring it back for a specific amendment at that time, if that's okay with you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. Mr. Clerk, when Senator Vrtiska withdraws his amendment, I want to withdraw mine which would probably follow it.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Vrtiska, I would recognize you. Are you withdrawing an amendment?

SENATOR VRTISKA: I would request to withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Vrtiska amendment to the amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, Senator Chambers, did I understand you want to withdraw...you don't want to offer yours then, Senator? Okay.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Chambers amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing pending to the Vrtiska amendment at this time.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We are now then back to the discussion on the pending Vrtiska amendment, AM3739. Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, Senator Vrtiska, could I ask you a question or so?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR HARTNETT: This is limited for two years, as I understand it?

SENATOR VRTISKA: That's right.
