1046 is what I wanted to clarify.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: No.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's...that's what I wanted to clarify. I understand 11...escaped my mind.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: 41.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: 1141, but there is no change in the 1046 fiscal note.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That is correct.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: This simply extends the time frame, and I support the bill.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yeah, so in essence, Senator Wehrbein, I believe that the 1041A (sic) can actually go away.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's what I would be understanding.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But I wanted to be sure 1046, your amendment didn't change any fiscal thing. I couldn't pick it up here, but I wanted to clarify that.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Right. It's the same exact amendment as we had on consent calendar, with the exception, I did put a sunset date on it to make sure to clarify that we are, indeed, trying...going to replace those evaluations with the community-based programs.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. And, with that, I support the amendment.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. There are no further lights. Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you like to close on your amendment?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I believe the explanation hopefully has been adequate and I would urge adoption of the amendment.
