

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah, yeah, that's what...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Quite honestly, I can't tell you that right now, I don't...I could, if I knew it.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Bernard-Stevens, your light is next.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Is mine the only light?

SENATOR WILL: No.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay. I'll go ahead briefly, in fact, I'll yield the first portion of my time to Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker, members, clarification on that. We, in the budget we have continued funding at Geneva and Kearney to keep the wing open because of the capacity that we're operating at. In that is a very small number to keep the evaluation open. I do not have those figures, I will have those on the A bill for Select and pull back, if necessary. The Corrections told us it was a very small number. I don't know what "small number" is in this case, but it is a very small part. That unit will be open anyway, as we've set it up to be open. And I'm not going to say that they can absorb it, I don't...I can't actually say that at this point. But it is a very small part because the wing is going to be open anyway, at least for one more year. And so carrying it into another year, the second year out, it would be very hard for me right now to give that number, but I will have that, if we can get it at all, before we come to Final Reading, so we know where this A bill is. But I'm going to assume that it's 25 to 50 thousand dollars at the very most.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you. Senator Bernard-Stevens, you want the rest of your time?
