SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Would members please return to the Chamber, record their presence. Those of you in the Chamber please record your presence. Any unauthorized individuals please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Lindsay, Senator Matzke, Senator McKenzie, Senator Robak, Senator Schimek, would you check in, please. Senator Jones, same thing, please. Senator Bernard-Stevens has authorized us to proceed. Mr. Clerk, there's been a request for a roll call in regular order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1182 of the Legislative Journal.) 12 ayes, 26 nays on the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is not agreed to. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Witek, but, Senator, I have a note you want to withdraw this one? This is AM3033, Senator.

SENATOR WITEK: 3033?

CLERK: 3033.

SENATOR WITEK: That's correct The first one is 3003 that I'm starting with.
