LB 1218A, 1248A, 1248

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, I'd like to respond but I...my grandmother told me a lot of things about that so, no, I'll close and I'd appreciate the advancement. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 1218A. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on 1218A. Have you all voted? Senator Kristensen?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I'd waive.

SENATOR CROSBY: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of 1218A.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill advances. LB 1248A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1248A by Senator Vrtiska. (Read title.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Vrtiska to open.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Crosby. This is the A bill with LB 1248 that we had discussion on this morning. This bill would appropriate 200,000 dollars in the Local Government Catastrophic Financial Emergency Fund, which is created by LB 1248. Two hundred thousand dollars would be available for the state's Claim Board to use in approving claims against the fund in any of the forms listed in LB 1248. Again, the 200,000 dollar figure is based on what we've been able to assess as the potential needs for the fund in the coming year, consistent with what we spoke about in the discussion this morning. I'd just like to advance the A bill to Select File so it can catch up with the bill we advanced to Final Reading this morning and, with that, I would ask for your support in advancing LB 1248A. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Discussion on 1248A? Seeing none, Senator Vrtiska. He waives closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 1248A. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Senator Vrtiska?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yeah, I'd like to have a call of the house and accept call-ins.
