PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. Senator Schellpeper, could I ask you a question, please.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator, you have a preference for going 65 on the two-lane roads. Let's say you're coming into Stanton and you're rolling in there at 65, and you slow down to, oh, let's say, oh,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Their limit is 35 in Stanton.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, let's say that you try to slow down, but you're not familiar, you get in there and all of a sudden you're going to get a ticket at let's say, I'm just trying to fish for one, 59 in a 35. How much of a fine should you be levied?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: A few years back I came through Octavia, which is a small town south of Schuyler, and the speed limit I guess was 25, I was doing 55, and that cost me \$75 and costs.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Including...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I thought that was too much.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Including costs?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: No, and costs.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And you realize that the amendment that you just endorsed, that would now be \$224?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, but I was going too fast, I guess, I didn't realize it was 25. I complained at the time, but I think it's probably okay.
