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CLERK: LB 253A, I have E & R amendments, first of all, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 253A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 253A. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 253A, excuse me, the E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad would move to amend the bill. (AM3711 may be found on page 1242 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Maurstad to open on his amendment.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, as a result of the Standing Committee amendments there needed to be a change in the fiscal note as a result of a \$20 fee per vehicle for a metallic assigned number plate when that's necessary because of not having identification on the car. And so this increases the expenses associated with the bill, cash funds about \$3,150. It also increases the revenue side of the A bill. The department is estimating that there will be \$20 a vehicle, more than enough additional revenue to take care of the expense, and so there actually is no additional cost and will, in fact, generate more revenue for the department. So it's a cash fund transaction and would ask for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Maurstad. Is there any discussion of the Maurstad amendment? Seeing none, Senator Maurstad to close.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: I'll waive closing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Maurstad amendment to LB 253. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay.
