CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Maurstad's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Maurstad amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 253A to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the advancement of LB 253A. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 253A advances. We'll turn now to General File and LB 1039A.

CLERK: Madam President, 1039A on General File. It's a bill by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on March 4 of this year.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to open on the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this is the A bill for 1039. LB 1039, you will recall, we amended LB 298 into it, which deals with homestead exemption and allowed medical expenses to be reduced, or deducted from the eligibility for income for the different categories. The '96-97 appropriation would be 6.2 million and the '97-98 would be 6.5 million. It needs to catch up with the enabling legislation. So I move the bill would be advanced.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 1039A? Seeing none. Senator Warner waives closing. The question before you is the advancement of LB 1039A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
