PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 932 advances. We will return now to LB 1336 on Select File.

CLERK: Madam President, 1336 on Select File, E & R amendments have been adopted. Senator McKenzie would move to amend with an amendment found on page 1173 of the Journal. (See AM3399.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator McKenzie to open on her amendment.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. This amendment is a technical amendment related to the changes in Senator Klein's bill relating to the excise tax or the checkoff tax collected for the Corn Board. You will recall that we set up a system to collect the excise tax last year, which parallels that. A change is made in his bill related to collection of...or a reimbursement for the tax on loans, corn which is sold on loans. Very simply it just parallels the language in Senator Klein's bill, technical in nature. I will yield my time to Senator Klein and if you have any questions, would be happy to answer them.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Klein, there's four minutes remaining.

SENATOR KLEIN: Well, I don't need four minutes. This is just to make sure there's no confusion between the two different checkoffs, so I appreciate Jan bringing this amendment to it and I support it wholeheartedly, so thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Is there any further discussion on the adoption of the McKenzie amendment? Seeing none, Senator McKenzie to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the McKenzie amendment to LB 1336. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator McKenzie's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The McKenzie amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.
