PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad, again.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, on St. Patrick's day I'd love to advance LB 1336 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 908 passes. LB 909.

CLERK: (Read LB 909 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 909 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1251 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 909 passes. LB 921.

CLERK: (Read LB 921 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 921 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
