

SENATOR BEUTLER: Passed out. It has...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Oh, all right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ..been filed and I think we can...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ..discuss it with...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yeah. Okay. Well, then I don't want to take further time from the body because we're starting to discuss something that Senator Beutler has now on file and I'm assuming that if I... Senator, I can yield you my time and you might withdraw the amendment so that we could consider the amendment you really want to bring.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: (inaudible).

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Wickersham, I'll take you up on that. Mr. Clerk, I'd withdraw or I'd ask unanimous consent to substitute the amendment that I just handed to you for the amendment that we're currently discussing.

SENATOR WILL: If there is no objection, it's so ordered.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Members of the Legislature...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you. Members of the Legislature, if you will look at the amendment that has been passed out to you already which has been withdrawn, I can use that very easily I think to describe to you the abbreviated amendment that is now before you, and the first thing you would do is to cross out everything after subsection (1), so everything in subsection (2), (3) and (4) is eliminated. Then, in subsection (1), the basic content of subsection (1) stays in place and two...it's...but it's molded in two respects. First of all, it requires that this function be done by January 1 of
