

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The functions remain.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So it would still say, on this person's door, county clerk, county assessor, county clerk of the district court, county engineer, and county surveyor, and registrar of deeds?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It would have all those listed.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct. They'd be responsible for all those functions and offices.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. The more I read this the less I like it. But to go back to Senator Bernard-Stevens' amendment, I support it.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Madam President, members of the Legislature. Senator Kristensen, could I ask you a question, please.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Is there any definition in law, or law standard defining good faith effort? I mean is that used in legal terms occasionally, or unoccasionally?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, it's been construed. I can give you the definition that normally would be used out of Black's Law Dictionary, and that's honesty of intentions and freedom from knowledge of circumstances which would... basically it's a good faith attempt. You could disagree. Just because you disagree doesn't mean that it's not good faith and you can state it in your terms. But basically it's some honesty of intention and freedom from knowledge of circumstances of which you ought to be put on notice, or which you have some inquiry. So that is the standard.
