

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...district?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right. But I think they go through the county to collect it, just like other special assessments.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So but that would...that would be added on to the county levy then, wouldn't it?

SENATOR BEUTLER: It would appear someplace on the tax statement you got from the county, I believe, either as a special assessment or as a property tax levy.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Or would that be on the whole county or just the property owners in that drainage district?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Just within the drainage district.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So this would...it would be just like a school district then, only the people in that district would be paying...

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...for that improvement on that drainage...

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...ditch. Thank you. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I am just going to make a brief comment. I've indicated a willingness to be supportive of a 206.
