

CLERK: Not at this time, Mr. President, thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 847A.

CLERK: (LB) 847A, no E & R. Senator Wickersham would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (Wickersham amendment, AM3684, appears on page 1193 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wickersham, you're recognized for your amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body the amendment should be in the Journal. It increases the amount of dollars in the A bill by \$11,755. That increase is due to an amendment offered to the bill on Select File. It was the contents of LB 986, roll-overs. It is in part for computer programming and other costs. The bill itself, of course, is an omnibus change to the retirement systems largely related to administrative matters, but the roll-over bill that was added on Select File deals with military retirement issues and the ability of individuals to roll-over other retirement funds into our state retirement plans as part of the contribution for buybacks. With that, oh, I would also note that the \$11,755 are not General Fund dollars, those are Cash Fund dollars. So, Senator Wehrbein, it has no impact on the General Fund. I would urge your support for the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. There are no lights on. You care to close? Closing is waived. The question is, shall LB...shall the Wickersham amendment be adopted to LB 847A? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING
