

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, it's hard not to reiterate here. How many ways is or are there to say I'm against this? I'm like Senator Lynch I guess. Otherwise, it will be a issue of the Legislature again to go into how those funds will be spent beyond that.
