

SENATOR WILL: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I will ask to ..I am going to ask to withdraw this amendment. I will speak to Senator Withem in a second about passing over the bill temporarily. My suggestion is, we debated about having a meeting in a committee room for those that are interested to come in and listen to Rod Armstrong, Larry Primeau, Miller, about the details, but we thought maybe it would be better to open the subject up first. I am thinking...I was thinking about going...if it'd go to Select File and then do that, or pass through General, if we could, and then go to Select to have your questions answered but I think maybe it would be just as well, if it is the will of the body, if it is acceptable to the body, to pass over per Senator Withem's suggestion so that those of you that are interested in more details can meet with those that are involved. I just answered some questions out there, by the way, other states have done, what some of you are proposing, and it doesn't run 30 million. It runs 48 million, it runs 17 million more to do it right. They have had advice from large companies to stick with focusing on the problem, and that is really what this is about. So in order those...to have those questions answered off the floor where you can have a room, we will set one up just as soon as we can, probably this week, if not, next week, so that you can get more detailed questions answered to the technical ones that you want, and Senator Withem ought to have control of it, I think, since his name is on the bill, and I will ask then to do that as soon as I can see what the proper procedure is. Senator Withem.
