

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion of the Bohlke amendment? Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Madam President. Senator Bohlke, I'm sorry, I...that went by me pretty quickly. Could I ask you to just briefly reiterate the intent of that amendment once again? I'm trying to follow it here.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Senator Bromm, this is a bill that was presented before the Education Committee and actually a situation that we have in Venango that the county superintendent brought to our attention in that it just says that if a district contracts out their high school, we...currently if a district contracts out their high school students, they need to have enough students to reopen the next year or to become a Class I, but there the exception is if they're more than 15 miles to the nearest high school. This amendment basically says that if a district contracts out all their students or their students, the board has waived the 15-mile exception so it's not going to allow those schools to contract their students out and then remain open for two years, three years.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. Okay. Thank you, Senator Bohlke.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Abboud. Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: I'll waive off.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any further discussion? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Madam President, members, I'd like to ask, Senator Bohlke, what's the number of this floor amendment? Is that...just so I know.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Amendment 3619. It's not a floor amendment, it's a printed amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I thought I saw FA. It's AM, okay, thank you. And would you...when you close, I just want to hear a minute of summary and that's all when you...I'll wait till you
