

issues on voter fraud here on the floor. I've tried to address some of those with my amendments. You can't think of everything so, hopefully, this is something that they'll include in the form that they'll ask the election commissioners to fill out, and once we get some of this information, we can do this evaluation on how this is all working out and make some adjustments here. I don't think it's asking too much. I don't think it will be an expensive process. It'll just be something that they can work with. There's already a lot of safeguards within the bill. There's already some reporting being done within the bill. So, I would ask for your adoption to include this in the reports and the information that they'll be collecting. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, and members, I talked with the Secretary of State's office. They agree. They probably would do this anyhow, but if it's in statute, that makes it all that much better so I do agree with the amendment and, again, it makes a good bill better. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Witek, do you have closing? Closing is waived. The question is, shall the Witek amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Witek's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Witek amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah, you certainly can have a machine vote on the advancement. I don't see the E & R chair. Senator Will, can you...Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Getting advice from...I move to advance LB 964 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The size of the briefcase is getting smaller, Senator Maurstad, I want you to know. (laughter)
