

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Janssen and Bromm, AM4023.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Madam Speaker, members, I would like to withdraw that amendment and substitute that with AM4070, please.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Janssen to open on the amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The amendment inserts some new language and forms a task force for unfunded mandates created by the Legislature, and the...have the copies been passed out? I don't think so. All right, what it does, it sets up the Chairperson of the Executive Board as one of the members of the council, and the Chairperson of the Education Committee, Chairperson of Revenue Committee, Chairperson of the Military...Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, Chairperson of the Health and Human Services, Chairperson of the Urban Affairs Committee, and five representatives of the political subdivisions selected by the members listed in subdivision, will include one representative of municipalities, one representative of counties, three representatives from the education community. I think I will ask...give the rest of my time to Senator Bromm to continue to discuss this amendment. Senator Bromm.
