ASSISTANT CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is now under call. All members please return to the Chamber, record your presence. The house is under call. We're voting on the question as to whether debate should now cease on the pending Wesely amendment. The house is under call. Members in the Chamber please take your seats, record your presence. Members outside the Chamber, please return. Senator Brown has authorized call-in votes. Senator, we've had a bit of a malfunction up here. The printout did not get taken so a roll call vote will be necessary. Senator Elmer, Senator Hartnett, Senator Hillman, Senator Janssen, Senator Lindsay, and Senator Schrock. We are proceeding to a roll call vote on the question of ceasing debate. Members, please check in. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on the pending Wesely amendment?

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1504 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 4 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Debate is ceased. Senator Wesely, you're recognized to close on your amendment. I'm going to leave the house under call just because we are closing and we'll be voting on the amendment.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. As indicated earlier, this is the Chambers amendment, stolen and expropriated by me. And what it does is it says "Regional and community representatives shall be involved at all stages in the implementation of this legislative bill." So I would ask your adoption to make sure that we have that involvement in the implementation. Thank you.
