SPEAKER WITHEM: That constitutes your opening. It's a debatable motion. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. President. I rise to support the amendment. Some might remember I raised some objection the last time, and I've talked to Senator Pirsch and she has graciously taken section...previous Section 98 out of the amendment that she withdrew tonight, and so with that, I'd be very supportive of the bill and want to, on the record, thank Senator Pirsch for her willingness to work.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Pirsch, you're recognized to close. Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to advance LB 948 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. Bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1039.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to return the bill. Senator, I have AM...well, I have two. First one is AM3564. You want to withdraw that.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: And Senator Warner would move to return for (AM)3885, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Warner.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This amendment is on page 1303 of the Journal. It does three things specifically. You will recall this is the bill that the homestead adjustment was attached to earlier during the session, and it is effective this year as it was drafted. The cut-off date under existing law for application is April 30. The amendment changed it for this year only to May 31
