

to provide more ample time for people to make applications or adjust applications for the changes that are proposed to take effect this year. Secondly, the amendment, as it was adopted, described nonprescription medicine as proprietary, and the amendment puts it in...strikes "proprietary" and puts "nonprescription" which, I guess, I believe is probably more readily understood. And then the third amendment is a part of what the bill was originally introduced to deal with, and it indicates that the applicant, the person signing, and the income that is to be measured is the owner-occupant of the home. I believe the word that was used was spouse. This request came from the Department of Revenue. It has what they would have preferred in the bill as originally introduced, and I'd move the bill be returned for the adoption of these three amendments or one amendment with three parts.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the opening. Is there any discussion? There is none. Senator Warner, would you care to close? The question is, shall LB 1039 be returned to Select File? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is returned. Senator Warner to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Members of the Legislature, I'd request the amendment, as described on the motion to return, be adopted.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Senator Warner to close. Closing's waived. The question is, shall the Warner amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1039 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the bill?
