LB 965, 1082, 1139

CLERK: LB 965. Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Mr. Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 965 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 965 to E & R for engrossment. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced.

CLERK: LB 1082. Senator, no E & Rs. The first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Pirsch and Lynch. I have AM...

SENATOR MAURSTAD: It's my understanding they wanted to withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: I don't have...

SENATOR CROSBY: All right. We'll pass over 1082 and go to LB 1139.

CLERK: LB 1139. Senator, Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (AM4122 is found on page 1517 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Beutler to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Crosby, members of the Legislature, this is just a very brief amendment. The bill, as you'll recall, provides for benefits to Nebraska National Guard personnel and their families in certain circumstances. It formerly applied to state supported universities. Senator Robinson is expanding that to include independent, not-for-profit, regionally accredited colleges or universities, and all I'm doing is clarifying that those independent colleges should be colleges in this state, which I think is the intent of the bill. So...and I think Senator Robinson is okay with the amendment. Thank you.
