

treas...at the request of a levying SID. Section 3 would exclude a holder of a tax sale certificate or deed from seeking to include in the foreclosure of a lien for taxes. Any lien for a special assessment levied by the SID when the land had not previously been offered for sale by the county treasurer at the request of the SID. It simply adds some integrity. Some of these were going out of state. And so I would ask for the adoption of this amendment.

No one testified in opposition of the bill. Right now we have two SID acts, acts of 1947 and acts of 1949. We did research. There's nobody acting under the 1947 act, and so what...this will strike or repeal all the parts of SIDs. So, we're cutting down on the law books, I guess. So, I'd ask...if there's no questions, I'd ask for the adoption of this amendment.
