

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (AM4124 is found on page 1520 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Crosby and members of the Legislature, this bill had a date on it of January 1, '96. I'm just changing it to January 1, '97, which I believe is okay with Senator Jones. It's not my favorite bill, as you might guess, although it would be nice if all of the public institutions in Lincoln paid a little tax to Lincoln. That'd be good. But there is a rationale for this. I understand how landowners feel. This is just a minor amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Discussion on the Beutler amendment? Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Madam President and members, I talked to Senator Beutler about this ahead of time, and I would go along with this date change on it to make it more...make it look like it's waiting a little bit before it actually takes place. So...but what this bill really does is make it more friendly between the landowners and Game and Parks in the country, and they'd kind of like to get it passed so that they'd be better neighbors out there. So, that's another reason. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Jones. Any further discussion on the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, Senator Beutler? He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 345. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Jones, did you have anything further to say? He waives closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 345. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.
