LB 108, 345, 345A

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 345.

SENATOR CROSBY: LB 345 is advanced. LB 345A.

CLERK: LB 345A by Senator Jones. (Read title.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Yes, this just shows how much more it will be in the next two years of '95-96, and '96-97. And none of this comes out of General Funds. This is all out of the Habitat Fund. So, with that...well...thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Discussion on 345A? Seeing none, Senator Jones, did you wish to close? He waives closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial, LB 345A. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the motion to advance LB 345A.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is advanced. We will now go to General File, LB 108. Mr. Clerk, do you need any...

CLERK: No, I'm fine, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: LB 108.

CLERK: Madam President, 108, a bill introduced by the Natural Resources Committee, has been presented to the Legislature on two occasions, March 13, again on March 21. Committee amendments have been offered. A series of amendments to the committee amendments have been dealt with, some of which have been adopted. The first amendment I have this morning is by Senator Dierks. Senator, I have Floor Amendment 553. It's on page 1296 in the Journal in front of me.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Dierks, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you. Madam President and members of the Legislature, Floor Amendment 533...553, I'm sorry, speaks to a specific fear of ground water users with this legislation.
