CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, on adoption of Senator Fisher's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any further...amendment is adopted. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schellpeper, to speak on the motion to advance.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I rise to support LB 1277. This is not any expansion in current gambling. This is just to allow the pickle operators to have one more avenue to, if you're a loser, and if you happen to have a certain number, you can win another prize. So it's just a little bit more that you can do with the pickle card, but it's not really an expansion of any gambling, so I would support LB 1277.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Will, do you have anything to say in closing?

SENATOR WILL: I would simply urge the body to advance LB 1277.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body is, shall LB 1277 advance? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1277.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1277 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1070.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1070 by Senator Cudaback. (Read title.) Introduced on January 5, referred to Natural Resources. I do have committee amendment pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: I would announce, before we get into this bill, because of the extreme controversial nature of this bill, we
