SPEAKER WITHEM: Kristensen amendment is adopted. Anything further? Senator Schrock, to speak on the advancement.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Kristensen, just briefly. You mentioned the fact that on a CDL if the federal ramifications of driving 15 miles per hour over, can you just briefly tell me what that's about?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay. There is a provision for, in the federal CDL and that we've done, that has certain penalties for a serious traffic infraction. In other words, that can subject you to some additional penalties. And we have to have a definition. The federal law says that if you travel 15 miles an hour or more, that that is...constitutes a serious traffic infraction. We've had in excess of 15 miles an hour in this state. We never had the words "at 15 or in excess of", so that's...that's how that comes into play. Quite frankly, if LB 901 passes, I don't think you're going to have those problems as great because that 15 mile an hour really is a considerable higher speed.

SENATOR SCHROCK: What are the penalties then?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I was just looking at legal counsel. It's disqualification. I believe it's 30 days disqualification of your license, your CDL privileges.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Withem, how much time remains on the bill?

SPEAKER WITHEM: About six and a half minutes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Senator Kristensen, just a question...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Sure.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...if I could.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, you're fine.
