CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 323A.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 323A advances. Mr. Clerk, we will...first of all, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein, Lindsay, Withem and Wickersham.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay. The...we...the amendment...we'll present a new amendment. Senator Wehrbein or Senator Lindsay, which of you are handling the amendment? Senator Lindsay, can you...would you open on the amendment, please.
