

Schmitt and I have discussed this. I believe he is all right with it. Basically, that particular section has to do with the firearms test, and it has a lot of details in it including the type of target and the scoring, and insofar as we are going to go into those kinds details, it seemed appropriate to me to ask them to set up a standard distance and to test them in the firearm that they are actually going to be using, and those are the only two suggestions I wanted to put forward. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Senator Schmitt, on the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR SCHMITT: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, I just rise in support of the Beutler amendment. Again, I feel this makes the bill better because this also addresses the qualification of the officer by the firearm that he is going to be using. So with that, I would ask that you adopt the Beutler amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers, on the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, and members of the Legislature, I just want to say that I agree with what Jesse just said with reference to Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any closing, Senator Beutler? The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Beutler amendment is adopted. Anything further?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad, or, Senator Schmitt, would you like to make a motion to advance your bill to E & R Engrossing?

SENATOR SCHMITT: I would just move to advance LB 1055 to E & R for engrossing.
