SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President. I would be happy to answer any other questions if it is unique to this section. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: So are you finished, Senator Kristensen?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I am finished. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you very much. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 681. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the Kristensen amendment to LB 681. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wesely offers 3935, but I have a note you want to withdraw 3935, Senator.

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR CROSBY: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Wesely would move to amend with AM4105. (See page 1430 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Wesely, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WESELY. Thank you. Madam President, members, the amendment before you doesn't deal with hospitals, so "Senator Radcliffe", you don't have to worry back there, no hospital language in this. I also want to note that it's five pages long. This is my amendment. This is Senator Kristensen's amendment. This is the big one we just adopted. This is a very small one, and we've been able to work through some of the issues involved, and I will read you a letter which has been distributed for you from Scott Moore and Mark Horton. Basically, this is a follow-up to a bill that we had last year dealing with PCs, professional corporations, and what we had is a situation where individuals, who were licensed primarily
