

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Beutler, did you wish to talk on the bill?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Kristensen, could I ask you just a couple more questions with respect to your particular amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, let me grab my copy of...I will listen.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And look at page 70.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, and I think this can be quick, but...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That's fine?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Section 95, at the bottom of page 70, has to do with the execution of contracts, and I assume that this provision is applicable to all three types of nonprofits, is that accurate, to begin with?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, I believe so.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And I assume that this would...is this the correct provision that would have to do with the execution of a deed or a conveyance of transfer? I am not sure if it's handled under general contract language or whether there is a specific provision. I...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I am thinking because I think there is another spot too, but I think that this will...I think there is another spot for deeds, to tell you the truth, I do.
