SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President...

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen, did you want to...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, I'd like to exercise my...I didn't punched my light. I thought I had it on and you were looking for other ones, so I apologize. If I may, can I take the opportunity to close?

SENATOR CROSBY: All right.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Because, Senator Brashear, and I see that he is visiting with Senator Wesely, what I would like to do and would suggest to the body, as a matter of comfort level is this, the amendment is a lengthy amendment. To make sure that Senator Brashear is comfortable that we are not placing impediments to that particular arrangement of profit, nonprofit, or to see what the standards are, to give you some time, I am going to ask and see if, if we can advance this on to E & R for engrossing, if we could hold the printing, final printing of the bill. I normally would never do that, but since it's substantial, if there is something additional that needs to be done, practically I don't want to go to the expense of printing the bill, pulling it back and reprinting it. That's sort of a waste of money, but if that's...if that will add to your level of comfort, Senator Brashear, would that...is that acceptable to you? And I see his head shaking, I can hear it, so I know that must mean it's an affirmative answer. With that, I appreciate the indulgence of the body, would be happy to talk to them in terms of what the amendment does and what the final piece of our business entity legislation for this session does, and would move this to advance to E & R Engrossing. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 681 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 681 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced.
