

CLERK: Next amendment, Mr. President, Senator Withem, I have a note that he wants to withdraw.

SPEAKER WITHEM: He has told me he will.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment by Senator Jones. I have a note, Senator, you wish to withdraw.
