

SENATOR WITEK: Thank you, Madam Chairman, members of the body. You just happen to have not quite gotten on the beam this time, but I forgive you, and I am not going to throw you away.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Seeing no further lights, Senator Pirsch, would you like to close on your amendment? Senator Pirsch, there are no further lights, would you like to close?
