the influence, is that it doesn't...you know, you just make the filing that they didn't have them and the order is issued. And the Department of Motor Vehicle has no knowledge of anything other than they've got an order to suspend the license, and they do it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So the way it works is if you don't come in in the ten days, then you can be convicted. If you do come in within the ten days, then the citation's dismissed, assuming you show you have...

SENATOR COORDSEN: That's the way the bill was originally written.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And then, regardless of what you do during the ten days, once you show that you've complied, you can go to the department and have everything wiped out and for no cost have your...

SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...have your polic...have your...have everything, all your certificates restored to you, or your license.

SENATOR COORDSEN: That is, that is this language in here.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Coordsen, your light's next.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Did you have anything else you wanted to add, Senator Beutler?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I don't think so. I think I understand it now.
