SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 901 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All of those in favor say aye. I think I may have heard at least one senator ask for a machine vote. Actually it was kind of a chorus. So we will take a machine vote on the motion to advance. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Senator Stuhr, you were one of the voices asking for a machine vote? I'm giving you credit for that. For the record we need to ask who, who made the request. Record, Mr. Clerk. And I believe I did hear Senator Witek request a record vote, is that correct? No, you need to request if you want a record vote with the names published in the Journal, you need to request that and that's what I interpreted your request to be, so the Clerk will now give us that information.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1613 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 12 nays on the advancement.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 901 advances. We will now move to Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 1044.

CLERK: May I read some things first, Mr. President?

SPEAKER WITHEM: You may.

CLERK: I have amendments to be printed, Senator Withem to 1205; Senator Vrtiska to 1114; Senator Beutler 1085; Senator Hillman to 292. A new A bill, 1322, by Senator Wesely. (Read LB 1322A for the first time by title.) Enrollment and Review reports 1120, 1191, 1265 as correctly engrossed. Senator Warner wants a meeting of the Revenue Committee upon recess...or I should say now, in five minutes. Revenue Committee now in Room 1520. (See pages 1614-17 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Wesely, I have a motion, Senator, I understand you want to withdraw that?
