LB 1090, 1268

CLERK: LB 1090, offered by Senator Pirsch. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred to General Affairs, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator...both of you are at your mikes. Senator Pirsch, are you opening?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes. Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the body, this is in the Liquor Control Act and deals with, if you'll look on page 5, a very minor part of that. Actually, LB 1090 would strike the provision on page 5, line 28 through line 4 on page 6, and that provision requires nonprofit clubs, and these are your VFWs, American Legions and so forth, which seek liquor licenses to file 2 copies which list the names and addresses of their members with the local governing body at the time of application for the license. This has, quite frankly, not been a practice that...and the Liquor Commission does not require this, and it is a source of confusion and consternation for those VFWs and American Legions because, of course, their membership lists are quite lengthy and really it's more red tape that has nothing to do with the way they run their operation and the management of that club. With that, I urge you to advance 1090.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Any discussion on LB 1090? There appears to be none. Senator Pirsch, do you have any closing? Closing is waived. The question before the body now then is the advancement of LB 1090. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1090.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1090 advances. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 1268, introduced by Senator Lindsay. (Read title.) Bill introduced on January 17, referred to the Banking Committee, advanced to General File.

SPEAKER WITHEM: No committee amendments?

CLERK: No committee amendments, Mr. President.
