

city or the county or the NRD or the fire district. Be prepared for the backlash in your community when that happens because it will be there when they discover the realities of having a large investment by the School Lands and Funds in your district. This is a prudent and reasonable way to go. I welcome the opportunity to debate it as much as anyone wants to again,...

SENATOR COORDSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...because it's the right direction. We have the facts behind us. We have the logic behind us, and it is simply the right decision at this point in time for the right reasons, not for the wrong reasons, which at some times in the past when we tried to sell this land, I haven't, but others, I think sometimes the wrong reasons have been propounded for the sale but I think we are doing it for the right reasons, and in the right way, and for my part, I think perhaps Senator Withem has improved the bill, and I appreciate that. It should make many of us more comfortable in supporting the bill. I thank you for your time.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the closing. The question before the body is a return to Select File for amendment of LB 1205. Those who are in favor of the return please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: We have an amendment to the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes, sir, the amendment is on page 1615.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Brcmm, to open on your amendment.
