

given some jicing which is unique and I do support this amendment and, once it's adopted, I will support the bill. There are a couple of other items that I will mention to Senator Maurstad briefly because I don't want to take the 30 minutes on the bill, but I want a couple of things in the record.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Thank you, Madam President, members. Would Senator Maurstad yield to a question.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes, Senator, I have one question. I wasn't involved in the negotiations on either side of this issue so I'm just coming up to speed with the amendment and the issue, but I did hear the bill in the committee and I know you had a concern dealing with high speed pursuits and you brought this bill in as...and it's been one of your priority bills here this year as well as your first year in the Legislature. Now, with the passage...with the attachment of this amendment and the eventual passage of LB 952, will this satisfy your concerns dealing with high speed pursuits, or will we have other legislation next year dealing with this topic from you?

SENATOR MAURSTAD: I think that...I think the amendment goes a long ways to addressing my concern. At this time, I don't anticipate having anything on this issue next year, however, I don't think that it would be in anybody's best interest for me to close the door relative to any other concerns that might arise. But, at this point, I have no plans to do anything further next year.

SENATOR ABOUD: Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. I rise in support of the Maurstad amendment. I'd first compliment Senator Maurstad, not only on his ability to work this through
