CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Maurstad, et al.'s amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: The next amendment, Madam President, Senator Maurstad, I understand you want to withdraw your amendment. Senator, is that right? (AM)3133, 3206 and 3134 are all withdrawn. Senator Beutler, you want to withdraw your amendment, Senator? (AM)3467 and 3468. Senator Maurstad would like to withdraw 3451. Senator Lindsay, you have a series of amendments, Senator. I have a note that you want to withdraw them but refile them. Is that correct?

SENATOR LINDSAY: That's correct.

CLERK: So that will apply to 3476, 3441, 3440, 3436, 3480, 3477-79, 2888, 3483, 3485, and 3486. Last amendment, Madam President, is by Senator Will. I have a note that Senator Will had wanted to withdraw his amendment. That's all that I have, Madam President, on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: They're all withdrawn. We're on the bill. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: My opening will be merely the amendment that we just adopted is now and becomes the bill and would ask for the advancement to E & R.

SENATOR CROSBY: There are no lights, Senator Maurstad. Do you wish to close? He waives closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 952. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 952.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill advances. LB 1226.

CLERK: LB 1226, introduced by Senator Bromm. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16 of this year, at that time
