

really puts downward pressure on anything untowardly being...trying to be accomplished. That has been the problem I think in some other states is a lack of full disclosure, a lack of information being made accessible not only to the public but also to the board of the nonprofit. This takes care of that. I think that is another one of the very good accomplishments of it is that we won't have the situations that Senator Matzke referred to in committee that were referred to in committee, for example, I think there is a case in Tennessee involving a hospital whose board didn't know what the purchase price was and those types of things; and this I think corrects a vast, vast majority of those evils that could occur. I think it improves the bill dramatically, from my viewpoint, something that Senator Matzke can live with. I would urge that the amendment be adopted.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. There are no further lights, Senator Matzke, do you want to close on your amendment?

SENATOR MATZKE: Yes, Madam President, and members of the Legislature, I think both Senator Lindsay and Senator Wesely have given a very good explanation of the rational basis for this amendment and the terms of it. I don't believe it is probably necessary to go into further detail. I would just urge all members of this legislative body to adopt this amendment and then later on advance the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Matzke. You have heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Matzke amendment to the committee amendments on 1188. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Matzke amendment. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Matzke amendment, have you all voted? Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Matzke's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Matzke amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.
