ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: There are no lights on, Senator Kristensen, I just realized I never gave you the opportunity to open, although you have had ample opportunity to speak on the bill, but you can open and close on your closing, if you would chose to.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Mr. President, I would waive both my opening and my closing.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on advancement of the bill Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER WITHEM: There are no further lights on, Senator Kristensen. Do you have anything further to add other than that compelling argument?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Ahhh, no. I would waive closing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question then is, shall we advance LB 465A? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.
