

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Jensen.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, Mr. President and members of the body. I would endorse moving this until Select File, because of the Attorney General's Opinion there is some ambiguity I think in this bill and my aide and Senator Schellpeper's aide will be working together before this gets to Select File, hoping that we can correct that particular issue. So I would urge that this be moved to Select File. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Senator Schellpeper, there are no lights on. Do you have a closing?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members. Once again this is just to basically strike Section 4, which deals with when a racetrack has to run according to current law. It gives the Racing Commission more authority according to the AG's Opinion and it also, this amendment would put the money where it needs to go to help the other tracks since Omaha is not running. So with that I would move for the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. I guess we will vote. I know I am trying to hurry things along a bit, but let's vote before I announce it is adopted. The question before the body is, shall the Schellpeper amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Members, have you all voted? I would ask if you could, members, be a little more observant of the activities in here.
