SENATOR PREISTER: Well, it...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...her resignation?

SENATOR PREISTER: I don't know that. She also didn't submit it again in July of '92.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Or July of '93.

SENATOR PREISTER: Correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Or July of '94.

SENATOR PREISTER: Correct. So it was...
