SENATOR AVERY: Could we have a call of the house, check in, roll call vote.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

Senator Chambers would like to put amendments to 1264; Senator Pirsch, 1213; Senator Hudkins to 256 and 256A; Senator Bernard-Stevens to 1264 and to 1085.
